Exams (Method of Assessment)	<p>Written, at the end of each semester.</p> <p>When exam papers have been returned after the winter semester, please take them to ZIB for them to note down your grades. This is important because ZIB is in charge of generating the Transcript of Records with the ECTS points achieved.</p>
Accommodation	<p>IMPORTANT: You have to apply for accommodation separately from applying for admission as a student. The online application for the university dorms can be made directly via https://tl1host.eu/SWK/index.html#admission Make sure to apply early. The deadline for housing applications is 15 July for the Winter term and 15 January for the Spring term</p>

<p>Other information specific to this institution</p>	<p>The University of Cologne offers a one month language course free of charge in advance of the winter semester. Students interested in taking this course should contact the ZIB.</p>
<p>Term dates for 2017/18:</p> <p>Winter semester (1 October – 31 March): Classes start on 9 October 2017 and end on 2 February 2018; examinations around the beginning of February.</p> <p>Summer semester (1 April – 30 September): Classes start on 9 April 2016 and end on 20 July 2016; examinations around mid-July.</p> <p>Holidays: Christmas holidays: shortly before Christmas Eve 2016 to 6 January 2018. Pentecost holidays: 22 May 2018 to 25 May 2018</p>
