NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Nomination deadlines

Spring semester (semester two) 2019/2020: Tuesday 15th October 2019

Fall semester (semester one) 2020/2021: Friday 15th May 2020

Spring semester (semester two) 2020/2021: Friday 2nd October 2020

Partner universities should submit their nominations at mic@univ-paris1.fr.

Application deadlines

Spring semester (semester two) 2019/2020: Wednesday 30th October 2019

Fall semester (semester one) 2020/2021: Friday 29th May 2020

Spring semester (semester two) 2020/2021: Friday 16th October 2020

After nomination deadline students will receive the application procedure. They will be asked to fill in <u>the online application form</u> and attach the following documents: a copy of passport, a certificate of French language proficiency, a learning agreement, the transcripts of records, a résumé, a cover letter and two recommendation letters. Students will then receive a certificate of admission and information on the necessary steps for the online administrative registration.

COURSES

Language Requirement

Courses at Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne are taught in French. Depending on the study cycle and the field of study, some courses may also be taught in English and in Spanish. Students are expected to have at least a B2-level in the language of instruction. A language certificate, or a letter from a French/English/Spanish language teacher, will be asked.

Learning Agreement

In order to fill in their Learning Agreement, students can choose courses from <u>the list</u> of courses open to the exchange students. In each department, an international relations delegate teacher is in charge of helping incoming exchange students for any questions about courses. <u>Here</u> are their names and email addresses.



ORIENTATION WEEK

Every year leading up to the start of the fall semester (semester one) in September and the start of the spring semester (semester two) in January, <u>orientation weeks</u> are held for incoming students. Students will be asked to fill out an application form online that will be sent to them prior to their arrival as places are limited.

ACCOMMODATION

Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne has some accommodation units allocated to exchange students. However the university does not have enough accommodation to meet all demand and can therefore not guarantee any student with an offer of university accommodation.

GRANT

Students who will be undertaking their period of mobility as part of the Erasmus+ programme International Credit Mobility will receive an Erasmus+ grant:

- between 275 euros and 1100 euros, based on the travel distance in order to support them in covering their travel costs. Travel distances are calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission. Please refer to mic@univ-paris1.fr to know the exact amount.
- a maintenance grant of 850 euros for each full month: the amount of grant paid is subject to
 adjustment depending on the actual duration of the mobility period undertaken. Due to the high
 cost of living in Paris, please be aware that the grant may not cover living expenses in Paris.
